Purpose of the Post

To allow the department to deliver courses in game development on the new BA Video Games Art & Design pathway.

Key Tasks

- 1.1. Deliver high quality teaching on the BA Video Games, Art & Design, with particular attention to courses focused on game development, MA1802 Immersive and Interactive Design; MA2802 Game Art, Design and Story; MA2803 Social, Mobile and Cloud-based Games; MA 3802 Game Play Mechanics, and to provide supervision for students on MA3803 Major Project.
- 1.2. Provide support and guidance to colleagues on the degree BA Video Games Art & Design.
- 1.3. Develop collaborative partnerships with external agencies for careers placements and guest contributions to the course MA\{\} Digital Creative Industries and \{\} Creative Entrepreneurship.
- 1.4. Contribute teaching to other courses as required.
- 1.5. Plan and deliver teaching using a range of techniques to inspire and engage students.
- 1.6. Identify learning needs of students and define appropriate learning objectives.
- 1.7. Design and develop own teaching materials, with guidance, if required.
- 1.8. Supervise the work of students, including their independent project work, and field trips / placements where appropriate.
- 1.09. Undertake administrative duties as defined by the Head of Department
- 1.10. Set and assess work for examination as directed by the Head of Department or Teaching Co-ordinator; select appropriate assessment instruments and criteria; and provide constructive and comprehensive feedback to students.
- 1.11. Undertake Personal Tutor duties, providing first-line support for students.

1.12. Engage in departmental activities such as attendance at Open Days and AVDs, as required.
