Purpose of the Post

To work with the RHUL investigator to initiate, develop, design and be responsible for the delivery of a programme of high-quality research in line as part of RHUL's programme of work on the IDRC funded project BAC4RumA "Bacteriocin-rich extract from engineered lactic acid bacteria as an antibiotic alternative for therapeutic and prophylactic use in ruminants and aquaculture". The post holder will be responsible for data analysis and writing academic reports/articles for the project outcomes.

Key Tasks

- Undertaking literature searches to specified parameters, data collection, management, and analysis.
- To seek new areas of related research and prepare and submit research bids and proposals that will enhance the reputation of the University.
- To prepare and present findings of research activity to colleagues for review purposes.
- To submit papers to appropriate journals and attend and present findings at appropriate conferences.
- To prepare progress reports on research for funding bodies as required.
- To contribute to and participate in knowledge transfer/exchange activities.
- To engage in scholarly activities needed to retain up-to-date knowledge of protocols and methods of analysis, for example, by regularly reading and peer reviewing relevant manuscripts, and by attending and contributing to relevant conferences and workshops internationally.
- To contribute to methods innovation and the sharing of good practice through seminars and workshops in the department.
- To promote the project outcomes through established communication channels (e.g. conference presentations, social media, web presence).
- Any other duties as required by the line manager or Head of Department that are commensurate with the grade.

Other Duties
